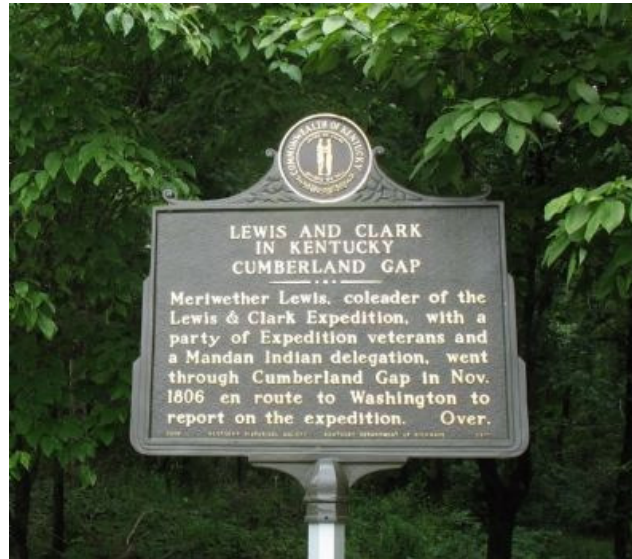

The Presentation

While traveling through the Cumberland Gap at the conclusion of the Lewis and Clark Expedition, Meriwether Lewis stopped to perform a survey of the line dividing Kentucky and Tennessee, commonly referred to as the Walker Line. Very little was known about this event, until Lorna Hainesworth undertook extensive research to answer some critical questions:

1. Why was the survey conducted?
2. How was the survey performed?
3. When did the survey occur?
4. Where is the exact location of the survey?
5. What were the results?
6. How do we know this?

Lunch Choices are:

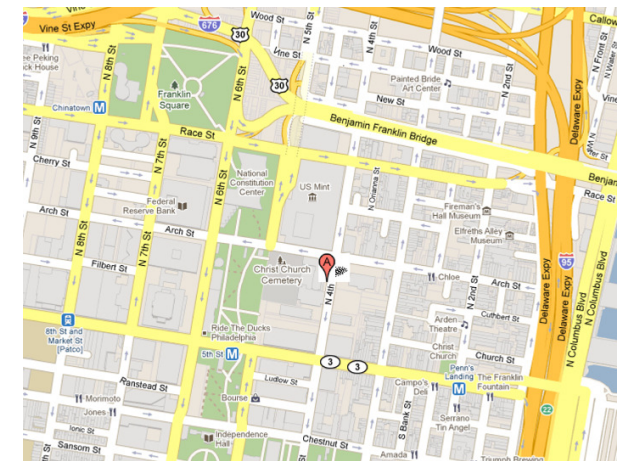
